Volunteers are needed to bring the Junior Achievement program, **JA It's My Future** to every 5th and 6th grade Highland Hills student this May! The teachers are very excited about this opportunity and need a volunteer in each classroom. The program offers practical information to help our students begin preparing for the working world. Students will learn to research careers, develop their personal brand, create a basic resume, recognize appropriate interview behavior, and more!

As a volunteer, you will guide students through six lessons. Junior Achievement (JA) provides training and an organized kit with all the materials. JA lessons are very descriptive with easy to follow, step-by-step instructions and you have support from the classroom teacher. The lessons include activities for students that are interactive, fun and engaging. You do not have to be a career expert; just bring your enthusiasm for helping students.
